Israeli boots in Gaza

The Israeli military said on Thursday it had begun conducting ground activities in the northern Gaza Strip, along the coastal route in the area of Beit Lahia, reports Reuters.

The advances on the ground by Israel on Wednesday — which included sending more troops to southern Gaza — threatened to drag the sides into all-out war again.

Israel has also issued new warnings to Palestinians to evacuate areas in the north and east of Gaza to avoid being trapped by any fighting and has reoccupied the key Netzarim corridor, a strategic strip of land in the centre of the territory that divides it into northern and southern halves.

The Guardian said at least 58 Palestinians have been killed and many injured in a third successive night of Israeli strikes across Gaza.

Gaza's civil defence agency said on Thursday that 504 people had been killed since Is-

rael resumed intense strikes on the Palestinian territory, reports Agence France-Presse (AFP).

"The total number of martyrs since the resumption of the aggression at dawn on Tuesday until noon today is 504 martyrs, including more than 190 children," the agency's spokesperson Mahmud Bassal said in a statement.

The timing of the strikes in the new Israeli offensive, which began on Tuesday, appears to have increased the proportion of women and children among the victims, with many sleeping when missiles strike.

A first wave of airstrikes on Tuesday shattered a two-month pause in hostilities and killed more than 400, according to the health ministry in Gaza, in what

may have been the single bloodiest day of the 18-month conflict. The dead included 183 children and 94 women, Palestinian officials said.

There was no immediate comment from the Israeli military on the most recent overnight strikes. Israeli media have reported that the new air offensive is aimed at senior political and military Hamas officials, and have identified some killed.

Lt Col Nadav Shoshani, a spokesperson for the Israel Defence Forces (IDF) said on Wednesday that Israel had attacked "dozens of terror targets and terrorists in Gaza, including Hamas commanders, to weaken their military and governmental capabilities and remove threats to Israel".

HAMAS HITS BACK WITH ROCKETS

On Thursday, Hamas armed wing claimed to have fired a barrage of rockets against Tel Aviv, in central Israel

The group said the attack was in response to "the Zionist massacres against civilians", reports Reuters

Three projectiles were identified crossing from southern Gaza into Israel, the Israeli military said. "The IAF successfully intercepted one projectile and two additional projectiles fell in an open area," it added

Israeli military intercepts Houthi missile

The Israeli military intercepted a missile launched by militants in Yemen, which triggered sirens across central and southern Israel, including Tel Aviv, early on Thursday.

The Israel Defence Forces said in a statement that the Air Force intercepted the missile before it crossed into Israeli territory and that the sirens were sounded "in accordance with protocol," Xinhua news agency reported.

Houthi forces in Yemen resumed their attacks on Israel, which ended a two-month ceasefire in Gaza by resuming airstrikes and sending in troops on Wednesday.

Earlier Yemen's Houthi group had announced the resumption of attacks against Israeli ships in the Red Sea, Arabian Sea, Gulf of Aden, and Bab al-Mandab Strait.

A report from Sanna said a new round of US airstrikes on Wednesday left at least nine people, including seven women and two children, injured in Yemen's capital Sanaa. The strikes targeted a building under construction in Sanaa's Geraf neighbourhood, damaging nearby residential structures and injuring civilians sheltering in an adjacent building, Xinhua news agency reported.

Wednesday's strikes also expanded to other regions, with al-Masirah reporting strikes on Houthi-controlled areas in governorates such as Saada, al-Bayda, Hodeidah, and al-Jawf.

Russia's Engels airbase on fire

The Russian cities of Saratov and Engels were targeted overnight in the heaviest drone attack against Saratov Oblast throughout the entire full-scale war, Governor Roman Busargin claimed, reporting a fire at a local airbase.

The attacks were conducted hours after US President Donald Trump and Ukraine President Volodymyr Zelenskyy had a telephonic conversation on taking steps on pausing the war.

Residents reported an air raid alert followed by a series of explosions in the region, according to Russian Telegram channels. At least four blasts could be heard at around 4 a.m. local time, the Kyiv Independent reported quoting Mash.

The cities of Engels and Saratov lie near the Engels-2 military airbase, which hosts strategic bomber planes regularly used for aerial strikes on Ukraine. The independent news channel Astra reported explosions near the airbase.

The Shot Telegram channel wrote that a fire also erupted in the area of a local oil depot in Engels. Russian officials have not commented on possible damage to oil infrastructure. Two civilians were injured in Engels, authorities said. Around 30 houses were impacted in the city, and windows of a local hospital, two kindergartens, and a school were damaged, Busargin claimed.

A state of emergency was announced in the Engels district in response to the drone

HUGE BLAST IN AIRFIELD

Ukraine struck a major Russian strategic bomber airfield on Thursday with drones, triggering a huge blast and fire about 700 km from the front lines of the war

The base in Engels, which dates back to Soviet times, hosts Russia's Tupolev Tu-160 nuclear-capable heavy strategic bombers, known unofficially as White Swans

Ukraine's defence ministry said its forces had struck the airfield and triggered secondary detonations of ammunition

Ten people were injured in the attack,

attack, and temporary flight restrictions were imposed at the Saratov and Samara airports. Saratov and Engels lie across from each other on the western and eastern banks of the Volga River, respectively, some 450 km from the Russia-Ukraine border.

Russian air defences shot down 132 Ukrainian drones overnight, including 54 over Saratov Oblast, 40 over Voronezh Oblast, 22 over Belgorod Oblast, and others over the Rostov, Kursk, and Lipetsk oblasts, as well as over occupied Crimea, the Russian Defence Ministry claimed.

One killed in BNP's factional clashes

Bangladesh witnessed a surge in violence as a factional clash between the Bangladesh National Party (BNP) left several injured in Chittagong district.

The conflict, which occurred on Wednesday night, involved supporters of former BNP Parliamentarian Giasuddin Quader Chowdhury and Chittagong district north BNP Convener Golam Akbar Khondkar, local media reported. During this, a local leader of the student wing of the party, Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) was critically injured. He succumbed to injuries while being transported to a Dhaka hospital on Wednesday night.

Several supporters from both sides were also injured. At an iftar party, tensions es-

calated when a group of people arrived and demanded that the event be stopped, leading to an argument. The situation led to a violent clash, leaving many injured. Locals said they heard gunshots during the clash, reports the The Daily Star. "Before iftar, police dispersed both groups, but they clashed repeatedly after iftar. Our initial investigation suggests that the

Golam Akbar group organised the iftar mahfil, but their rivals attempted to stop it, triggering the violence," said the officer-in-charge of the district Police Station.

Trump plans order to shut down US Edu Dept

President Donald Trump plans to sign an executive order Thursday calling for the shutdown of the US Education Department, according to a White House official, advancing a campaign promise to eliminate an agency that's been a longtime target of conservatives.

The official spoke on condition of anonymity before an announcement.

During campaigning, Trump promised to close the department "and send it back to the states, where it belongs". Trump has cast the department as a

hotbed of "radicals, zealots and Marxists" who overextend their reach through guidance and regulation.

However, finalising its dismantling is likely impossible without an act of Congress, which created the department in 1979. A White House fact sheet said the order would direct Secretary Linda McMahon "to take all necessary steps to facilitate the closure (of) the Department of Education and return education authority to the States, while continuing to ensure the effective and uninterrupted delivery of services, programmes, and benefits on



which Americans rely". The Trump administration has already been gutting the agency. Its workforce is being slashed in half and there have been deep cuts to the Office for Civil Rights

and the Institute of Education Sciences, which gathers data on the nation's academic progress. Advocates for public schools said eliminating the department would leave children behind in an American education system that is fundamentally unequal.

"This isn't fixing education. It's making sure millions of children never get a fair shot. And we're not about to let that happen without a fight," the National Parents Union said in a statement. The White House has not spelled out formally which department functions could be handed off to other departments, or eliminated altogether.
